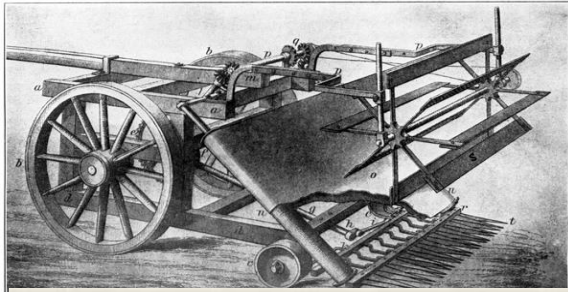
COTTON GIN

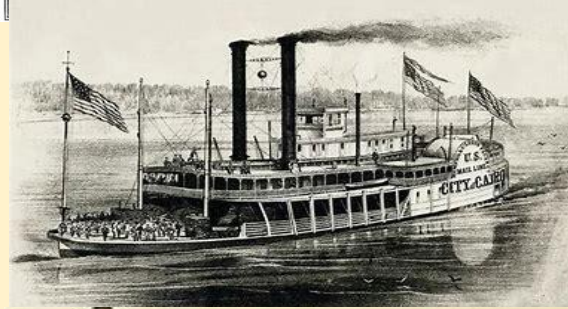

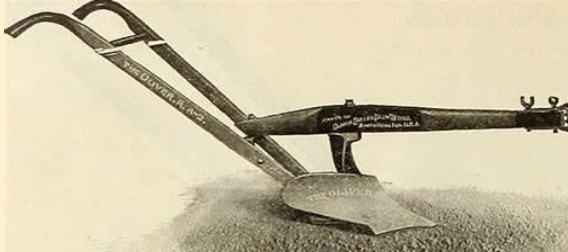
I was invented by Eli Whitney in 1793.

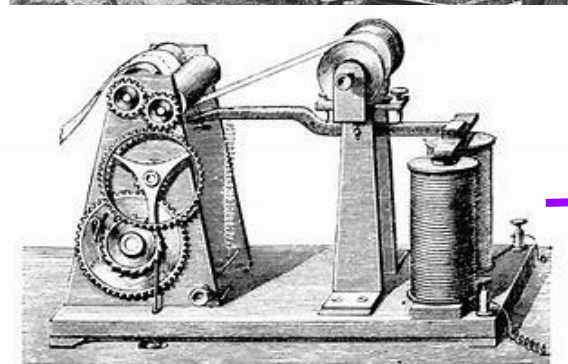
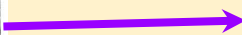

Black History Month - Frederick Douglass

1818

Publishes *Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglass, An American Slave.*

1838

-Born into slavery in Talbot County, Maryland

1841

-Publishes his newspaper, *The North Star*

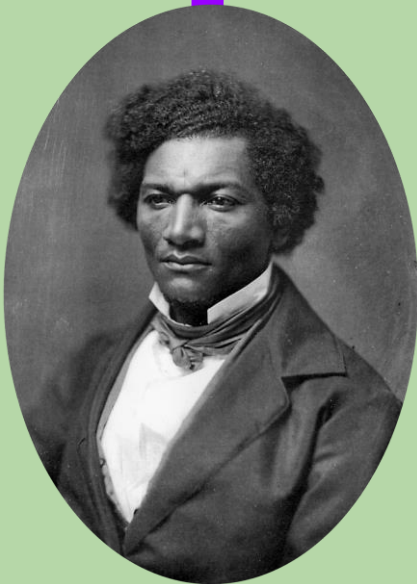
Escapes to freedom in the North and marries Anna Murray of Baltimore, MD

1845

-Begins to speak about the abolitionist movement

1847

-Hired as a lecturer for the Anti-Slavery Society
